

Student Owned Electronic Device Acceptable Use Addendum

The District permits use of the personal telecommunications or other electronic device by students for instructional purposes while on campus.

RULES FOR APPROPRIATE USE

- When using the device for instructional purposes while on campus, you must use the District's wireless Internet services and are prohibited from using a personal wireless service. The District's wireless network system must be disconnected from the device when the device is not being used for instructional purposes.
- When accessing the District's technology resources using your personal device, you must follow the Student Acceptable Use Agreement and the Student Owned Electronic Device Acceptable Use Addendum you signed for access to the District's technology resources.
- When not using the device for instructional purposes while on campus, you must follow the rules and guidelines for non-instructional use as published in the student handbook. These require the device to be powered off and stored out of sight.

CONSEQUENCES FOR INAPPROPRIATE USE

- Suspension of access to the District's technology resources;
- Revocation of permission to use personal electronic devices for instructional purposes while on campus;
or
- Other disciplinary or legal action, in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and applicable laws.

The District is not responsible for damage to or loss of devices brought from home.
